Morehead State football opens the 2010 campaign with one of the biggest tests the Eagles have faced since moving to non-scholarship. MSU will travel to Harrisonburg, Va. to face one-time Football Championship Subdivision national champion James Madison.

The Eagles have a new look and new attitude that coach Matt Ballard says is completely different than in recent years and he's hopeful that will lead to a reversal of fortunes from the 2009 season.

MSU is coming off a stellar defensive season when it ranked nationally first in tackles for loss, fourth in rushing defense and seventh in overall defense. The loss of three key defenders puts the responsibility for continuing the tradition of stifling defense on experienced players like Jerome Raymond and Mark Hall. The two defensive ends will be joined by an experienced pair of linebackers in Keaton May and Tony Bachman. D.J. Smith and Kameron Scott anchor the secondary, a unit that has out-performed pre-camp expectations.

Many of the Morehead fans though, will be focused on the offense. While it was able to move the ball effectively at times last season, the Eagle offense had trouble scoring. A key to MSU's turnaround, the offense has a new look and feel to it. Experienced running backs like Desmond Cox and Ronnie McDermott give leadership and up-and-coming wide outs Donte Sawyer, Jaison Yoshimura and Andre Williams have shown a lot of promise. A lot of the preseason buzz is around sophomore quarterback Zach Lewis. Lewis cut his teeth last year, learning the basics of Ballard's offense and adjusting to the speed of the college game. Now the all-time leader in high school passing yards in Kentucky will take the reigns.

A full scholarship FCS program, JMU finished fifth in the Colonial Athletic Association race last season with an overall record of 6-5 and a CAA mark of 4-4. The Dukes, the 2004 national champion return 43 lettermen and 13 starters from last year's team.

MSU Notes

DEAD EVEN

When Morehead State opens the season Saturday night at James Madison, it will be looking to stay on the positive side of its all-time season opener record. The Eagles are 39-38-3 in season openers. Coach Matt Ballard is 10-6 in season openers at MSU. He's even on the positive side on season openers away from Jayne Stadium, posting a 4-3 record in season openers on the road.

OPENING ON THE ROAD

MSU's record in road openers all time is 25-49-4. In road openers that were also season openers, the Eagles are 12-21-2. Ballard is 6-10 in road openers at Morehead State, but he's an even 3-3 when the first road game is also the season opener.

VS. SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS/FCS

Morehead State has played a fully-funded scholarship program every year for the past six years. Facing James Madison will make this the seventh year.

COACHING TIES

James Madison Assistant Head Coach/Offensive Coordinator Jeff Durden was at one time an Eagles coach under Ballard. While at MSU Durden coached the running backs and was the offensive coordinator. In 1997 the Eagles led the nation in scoring offense and were second in total offense.

DUELING THE DUKES

It's been 23 years since James Madison and Morehead State tangoed. The two teams met six times previously over a span of eight years, but have now gone more than two decades with playing. JMU, who holds a 4-2 advantage in the series, won the last meeting 44-10 in 1987.

COLONIAL CONTESTS

James Madison is the only team from the current Colonial Athletic Association football conference that Morehead State has played. Georgia State, MSU's Oct. 2 opponent is a CAA school in most sports, but as a first year football program, the Panthers have not joined the CAA in football.

DEFENSIVE STALWARTS

Last year the Eagles had a strong defense. The Eagles finished the year ranked first in tackles-for-loss per game (9.91), fourth in rushing defense (72.45 yds/g) and 7th in total defense (266.27 yds/g). The Eagle defense returns three of its top tacklers from 2009, Tony Bachman, Keaton May and Ryan Williams.

ARMCHAIR QUARTERBACK

Morehead State starting quarterback Zach Lewis was among the elite in Kentucky High School history. Lewis hold the record for career passing yardage and was in the top 10 of other records. He broke former NFL quarterback Tim Couch passing yardage record.

WELCOME BACK

Morehead State welcomes the return of both its top rusher from 2009 in Desmond Cox and its top receiver in Ronnie McDermott.. The two combined for over 1100 all-purpose yards last season, more than a quarter of MSU's total APY of 4181.

FREE FOOTBALL

It WAS rare that Morehead State needed overtime, but that changed last year, the first time MSU has needed multiple overtimes in one season. Since overtime was instituted in 1996, MSU has only played in six OT games with a 2-4 record. The Eagles first extra period was in 1998, a 35-34 win over Dayton. That was also the only OT game played at Jayne Stadium until last year's loss to 28-21 Butler. The 13-10 OT win at NCCU last season was the first time MSU has won a road overtime game.

Matt Ballard - Head Coach

Morehead State University's all-time winningest football coach, Matt Ballard is now in his 17th season in charge of the Eagle football program. A finalist for the Liberty Mutual Coach of the Year Award for two of the past three seasons, he is a four-time Pioneer Football League South Division Coach of the Year, having led the Eagles to four consecutive division crowns from 2002 through the end of divisional play in 2005.

Ballard is a former head football coach at Union College and assistant head coach and defensive coordinator at MSU. In his 16 seasons, he has taken an MSU program in transition and ravaged by transfers following the departure of the previous coaching staff and led the Eagles to the four championships and to a school-record nine wins on two occasions. His 21-year career record is 124-109-1 and his MSU record is 90-84.

In addition to his PFL South Division Coach of the Year honors, he has been a National Coach of the Year (1998) for NCAA Division I-AA (FCS) Mid-Major schools and Coach of the Year among NCAA Division I-AA Independents. The 1998 Eagle squad was ranked number one among Division I-AA Mid-Majors by The Football Gazette.

He has directed MSU to NCAA national statistical championships in rushing defense (2007), tackles for loss (2009), scoring offense (1997 and 2000), total offense (2000) and punt returns (1997). In 2003, defensive back Charlie Byrd led the nation in passes defended. In 2005, then freshman Nick Feldman led the nation in punt returns. In 2007, defensive back David Hyland led the nation in interceptions per game. Ballard has coached national players of the year among NCAA Mid-Major schools. They include David Dinkins (Offensive Back and National Player-of-the-Year), Doug Turner (Offensive Back), Bubba Combs (Offensive Lineman) and Toby Moeves (Specialist).

A 52-year old native of Davidson, N.C., Ballard compiled a 35-25-1 record in his six seasons (1988-93) directing the Union football program. He led Union to its best single season record and to the institution's first Mid-South Football Conference championship. He was named Mid-South and NAIA District 32 Coach of the Year in 1992.

He was on the MSU football staff for four seasons (1984-87) before accepting the head coaching position at Union.

Ballard was a four-year (1980-83) offensive/defensive coordinator at Georgetown College and spent one season (1979) as an assistant at Gardner-Webb. A graduate of North Mecklenburg High School in Charlotte, he earned a bachelor's degree from Gardner-Webb in 1979 and a master's degree from Georgetown in 1980.

He is active in many community service projects, especially in the area of child abuse prevention. Ballard actively supports two scholarship funds named in honor of his son, Matthew, one at Rowan County Senior High School and one at Morehead State University.

Matthew was an MSU student and a student coach on the Eagle football staff when he was tragically killed in a motorcycle accident on July 12, 2005.
